

STILL ROLLIN' KICKS OFF BIG WEEKEND WITH FREE FRIDAY NIGHT CONCERT APRIL 1ST

Clermont, FL (March 23, 2016) --- Friday April 1st in Historic Downtown Clermont is First Friday Family Food Truck Night which includes Music On Montrose, the free monthly concert series in City Hall Park. Friday's featured band is STILL ROLLIN', a trio featuring singer/songwriter Jim Reddin playing Americana/Folk music in the style of John Prine, Gordon Lightfoot, Gram Parsons and many others. Thirteen gourmet food trucks help feed the Friday night guests in the heart of Clermont. Saturday features several free attractions: The Youth Art & Culture Fest; the Annual Sidewalk Chalk Art Contest; Food trucks and vendors offering various "flavors" of the world; a Classic Auto Rally of 1950's & 1960's French Autos (Renault, Peugeot and Citroen); and, Saturday's finale - another free concert featuring the newly signed to Radio Disney boy band SLEEPING SUNSET. Activities continue Sunday with the weekly Downtown Clermont Farmer's Market.

Food trucks begin serving at 5:30pm Friday around City Hall Park at 7th and W. Montrose Street. Still Rollin' performs from 6:00pm til 9:00pm from the steps on the west side of City Hall. Vendors will display their wares under the lights in tents between 7th & 8th Streets on Montrose. Space is available and must be reserved in advance. Business exhibitors are permitted as are artists, crafters, jewelers, and other interests. Music On Montrose is sponsored by The GCI Guys at Re/Max Prime Properties. Sponsorships of the stage, tower lights, food trucks and other portions of the event are available for corporate sponsors. Guests are encouraged to bring blankets and lawn chairs. Residents, friends, family and tourists of all ages are invited. Free parking is available in City Hall parking lots as well as at City Center and other parking lots in the area.

As of press time, a few vendor/sponsor spots remained for Saturday's Youth Art & Culture Festival. This event encourages youngsters to discover and develop an interest in the Arts. Businesses, arts and culture groups, arts groups (dance, vocal and Instrumental music, heritage, etc) should check out this event. Stage time and street performance time is limited; however, please contact us if your youngster or group should be considered for performing during the event.
