

## SOCK HOP THEME FOR JUNE 3rd FREE CONCERT AT FIRST FRIDAY FOOD TRUCK EVENT

A few picnic tables are available on City Hall Park lawn. Lawn chairs, blankets and umbrellas are suggested. Free parking is available at City Hall and surrounding areas.

As a bonus attraction, the Orlando City Lions Major League Soccer (MLS) team will be represented at the City Hall Park sponsor area with a canopy tent.
