

“HURRICANE MATTHEW MAKE GOOD” FOOD TRUCK FRIDAY AND MUSIC CONCERT OCTOBER 21

Clermont, FL – (October 14, 2016)

Hurricane Matthew forced the postponing of First Friday Food Trucks & Music On Montrose. Friday October 21, 2016 is the “Matthew Make-Good Party!” at City Hall Park, 7th and W. Montrose Street in Historic Downtown Clermont. Food serving begins at 5:30pm. The free concert starts at 6:00pm. Vendors on Montrose and downtown businesses will be open late. The event concludes at 9:00pm. There is no admission fee and parking is free. Food Truck menu prices vary. Everyone is invited to bring a lawn chair, blanket, family and friends. This event is hosted and produced by the Clermont Downtown Partnership, a group of business and property owners in the Historic Downtown Clermont District. Other events the CDP hosts are: Farmer’s Market (every Sunday), Harvest Festival (Saturday October 29), Downtown Clermont Art Festival / Champions for the Arts (November 5th & 6th), 2nd Saturday Classic Car Cruise In, and other events.

The La Grange Band with Jim Reddin and Still Rollin’ is the featured band playing Americana Folk Country Blues. Back by request, Still Rollin has played Music On Montrose in the past and will be joined by members of The La Grange Band, from Eustis, FL area.

Thirteen food trucks are scheduled to serve. They include: Kona Dog, Camel Tow Tacos, Frenchy's Crepes, Korean Taco Box, TJ's Seafood Shack, Over Rice, Peru Power, Wholey Smokey Waffles, Froby's Ice Cream,

Saxophonists Jay Guess will provide music on Montrose Street near the South Lake Art League Gallery during this event. Shops in the Downtown area will be open late and vendors will have displays on Montrose Street from 7th to 8th Street.
